



CAMPER CONDITIONS REQUIRING A DOCTOR'S NOTE
(Clearance for Return to Camp)
2021

- **Acute illness:** If a camper is sent home from school due to concern(s) that warrant further investigation by a healthcare provider for a complete evaluation and diagnosis
- **Communicable disease:** If a camper is diagnosed with a communicable disease
- **Short-term absence:** If a camper is absent from Camp for one or more days due to a medical procedure, surgery, or significant accident or injury that will require accommodations upon returning to school
- **Prolonged absence:** If a camper is absent from camp for four or more consecutive days due to an acute or chronic illness

Campers may return to Camp following COVID-19 symptoms, exposure, or diagnosis after:

- Being free of vomiting, diarrhea, or fever for at least 48 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication (Tylenol or Advil), and
- Negative COVID-19 test results are submitted, and
 - At least ten days have passed from the time the individual tested positive for COVID-19, regardless of whether he/she was symptomatic or asymptomatic
 - At least ten days have passed since an individual has had close or proximate contact with a person with COVID-19 for a prolonged period of time and was experiencing COVID-19-related symptoms
